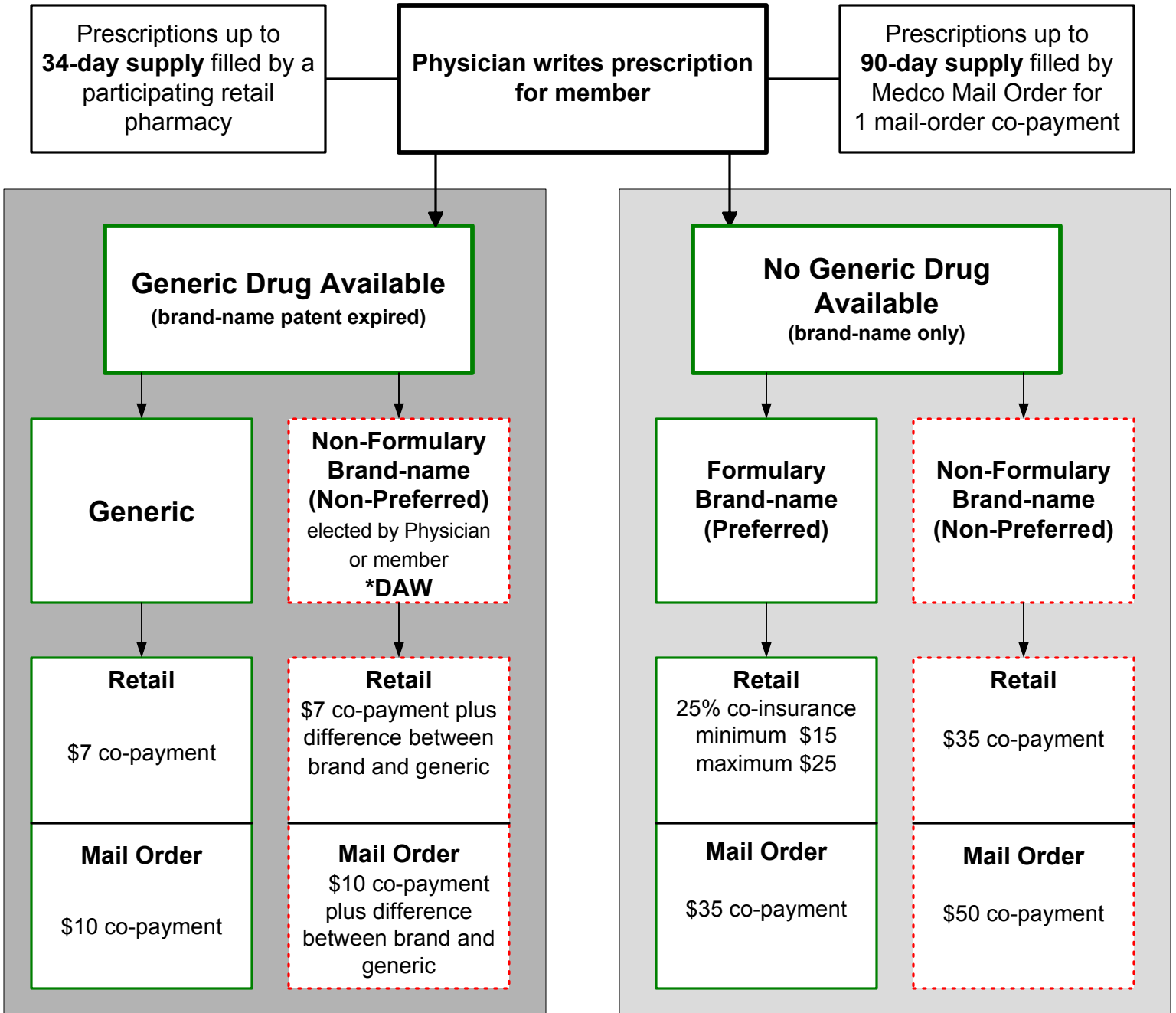

* Dispense as Written (DAW) - If the Physician requests the brand-name by indicating DAW on the prescription or the member elects the brand-name drug (when a generic is available), the member is responsible for the generic co-payment plus the difference in cost between the brand-name and the generic.
